Saved Through Water...

As we begin the season of Lent this month, we prepare ourselves for a journey once more; a journey with Christ that takes us from the source waters of baptism to the foot of the cross.

The placing of ashes on the forehead is a sign of penitence and a reminder of human mortality. The ashes remind us that we are from dust and to dust we shall return.

Thankfully, ashes are not the only mark we bear. In Holy Baptism, we have been marked with the sign of the cross. The cross marks us as “one redeemed by Christ the Crucified.” The ashes will wash off, but the mark of the cross is permanent.

Jesus led the way for all of us through His Baptism. Paul reminds us, “Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? We were buried therefore with Him by Baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life” (Romans 6:3-4).

Here, at the beginning of His ministry, Jesus leads the way through the waters of life and death. He offers us new birth through Baptism into the Name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. There is death, yes—death for our old sinful nature, and death for the evil that clings to us so closely and infects our hearts and minds. And that is

frightening. But it is so worth it. Through Baptism, Jesus gives us everlasting life and joy as God’s own beloved children, both now and on the day He returns to raise us all from the dead.

Lent is a 40 day stretch of time that the church has set aside for the believer to carefully examine his or her faith and life under the cross of Jesus Christ. Lent is a time for special attention to learning and growing in the faith, for repentance and prayer, and even for fasting for the purpose of sharpening self-control and our reliance upon the Holy Spirit.

Remember this Lenten season what Jesus’ life, suffering, death and resurrection means for our lives now. He spared nothing to make Himself known to us... a fact that

proclaims in no uncertain terms how “God so loved the world.”

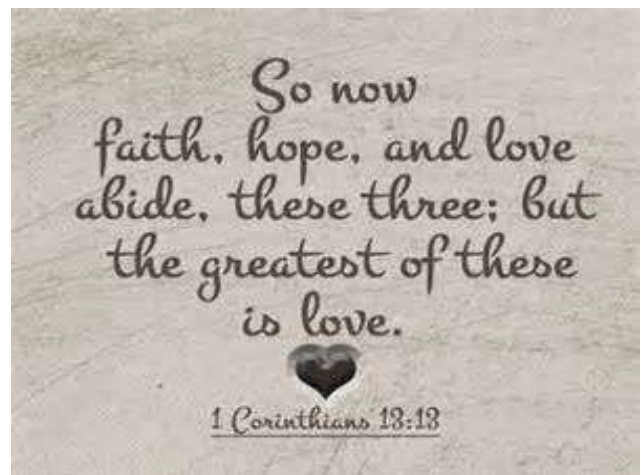

Stewardship Corner...

The three words “I love you” are very powerful. Love is expressed not only in words, but also in action. In fact, it has been said, “Talk is cheap.” To tell someone that you love him is certainly not cheap, but love also needs to be expressed by what we do and how we act. As God’s people, we convey love through our giving and serving.

In God’s Word, He tells us how much He loves each of us and then proves it by giving His Son to die for us. *“For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life”* (John 3:16). Jesus gave His life for us and He keeps on giving. We can demonstrate our love for Him through our giving. When we give faithfully of our time, talents, and treasures, we show our love for Jesus.

God takes love seriously. He loves us, and He expects us to love one another. Jesus said, *“Love one another as I have loved you”* (John 13:34).
